Governor Eric Holcomb appointed Chandler Lighty as the Executive Director of the Indiana Archives and Records Administration in August 2018. Prior to this appointment, Lighty directed the Indiana Historical Bureau. He previously held positions as project manager for Hoosier State Chronicles, and as assistant editor with the Papers of Abraham Lincoln. He earned a Masters of Arts in American History from Miami University.

Lighty's other professional service roles include the boards of the Indiana Association of Historians, the Indiana Magazine of History, the Indiana Historic Preservation Review Board, and the General Lew Wallace Study and Museum.
